## **Monday Afternoon at the Movies**

### **May 3, 2010 – Tucker: The Man and His Dream:**

*Francis Ford Coppola's* underrated biographical film of Preston Tucker (*Jeff Bridges*), designer and entrepreneur, who revolutionized Detroit in the 1940s with his "car of tomorrow." The "Tucker Torpedo" automobile featured groundbreaking innovations that later became standard use in modern cars. Three *Oscar* nominations including *Martin Landau* who won a *Golden Globe* award for best supporting actor as the investor who became Tucker's best friend - 1988 - Color - 110 minutes - PG.

### **May 10, 2010 – Cactus Flower:**

Delightful comedy about a bachelor dentist (*Walter Matthau*) who, in order to avoid commitment, tells his young girlfriend (*Goldie Hawn*) that he is married with children. When the couple decide to tie the knot, the girlfriend insists on meeting his first wife. *Goldie Hawn* won an Oscar and *Ingrid Bergman* won a Golden Globe for portraying the dentist's receptionist – 1969 – Color – 99 minutes – PG.

### **May 17, 2010 – Inglourious Basterds:**

Quentin Tarantino's highly acclaimed, and highly violent, World War II film about a small group of Jewish-American soldiers under the command of Aldo Raine (*Brad Pitt*) who terrorize Nazi soldiers in Occupied France. Eight *Oscar* nominations including Best Picture and Best Supporting Actor for *Christoph Waltz* for his unanimously praised portrayal of the evil SS Colonel, Hans Landa – 2009 – Color – 153 minutes – R.

### **May 24, 2010 – Rope:**

Chilling film directed by *Alfred Hitchcock* about two young intellectuals (*John Dall* and *Farley Granger*) who murder a former classmate (*Dick Hogan*) in their apartment and hide the body in plain sight. The murderers proceed to host a dinner party at the murder scene with guests that include the victim's father (*Sir Cedric Hardwicke*), his fiancée (*Joan Chandler*) and *James Stewart* who portrays a former teacher of the murderers who unwittingly inspired the crime – 1948 – Color – 80 minutes – NR.
